SUMMER TERMS 1&4

- Summer dress, **OR**
- White short sleeve shirt with navy tailored shorts or pants, **WITH**
- White ankle socks and black leather velcro strap school shoes for K-Y1 and black leather lace-up school shoes for Year 2 onwards

WINTER TERMS 2&3

- White long sleeve shirt with tartan tunic and navy long socks for K-Y2 or navy opaque tights for Y3-4, **OR**
- White long sleeve shirt with navy tailored shorts or pants and white socks **WITH**
- Black leather velcro strap school shoes for K-Y1 and black leather lace-up school shoes for Y2-4
- School blazer from Year 1 onwards

Year 5 - Year 9 Girls

SUMMER TERMS 1&4

- Summer dress, **OR**
- White short sleeved shirt with navy tailored shorts or pants, **WITH**
- White ankle socks and black leather lace-up school shoes

WINTER TERMS 2&3

- White short sleeve shirt with tartan skirt and navy opaque tights **OR**
- White short sleeved shirt with navy tailored shorts or pants and white ankle socks, **WITH**
- Black leather lace-up school shoes
- School blazer

Note: White socks and shoes are not sold in the Uniform Shop

Year 10 - Year 12 Girls

SUMMER TERMS 1&4

- Blue and white striped short sleeve shirt, **WITH**
- Navy skirt, **OR**
- Navy tailored shorts or pants, **WITH**
- Black ankle socks and black leather school shoes

WINTER TERMS 2&3

- Blue and white striped short sleeve shirt, **WITH**
- Navy skirt and navy opaque tights, **OR**
- Navy tailored shorts or pants and black ankle socks, **WITH**
- Black leather school shoes
- School blazer

Note: Black socks and shoes are not sold in the Uniform Shop

Kindergarten - Year 12 Boys

ALL YEAR

- Pinstriped short sleeved shirt (long sleeved version optional in winter for K-Y6)
- School tie (different ties for K-Y6, Y7-9 or Y10-12. Elastic ties available for K-Y2)
- Grey tailored shorts (long pants optional in winter), **WITH**
- Grey Pittwater House socks
- Black leather school shoes (velcro strap school shoes for K-Y1 and black leather lace-up school shoes from Year 2 onwards)
- School blazer (required in winter for Y1-12)

KINDERGARTEN - YEAR 12

- Sport polo shirt

- Bucket hat - compulsory for Pre-K to Year 6, optional for Years 7 to 12
- Cap - optional in Years 3 to 6 for Friday sport only, optional for Years 7 to 12

Uniform Policy

Uniforms and Appearance

The School uniform should always be worn correctly. This means that students may not mix and match items of sport uniform and the regular uniform. Full school uniform is always to be worn to and from school, even if travelling by car or bus. The uniform needs to be worn correctly both at school and in the general public.

Kindergarten to Year 6 students wear their sport uniform to and from school on Fridays and also on the allocated day they have practical PDHPE lessons as a class.

Years 7-12 must always wear their full school uniform to and from school and change into their sport uniform at school if they have training or practical PDHPE lessons. Any exceptions to this rule for special events will be clearly communicated.

Uniform for after-hours events held at School:

There will be times such as weekend events or being in the audience of a school major production, where casual clothing is acceptable. However, for formal school organised events such as parent teacher evenings and parent and student information sessions, students are required to attend in full school uniform. Students should always double check if they are unclear on uniform expectations.

Uniform for Excursions: When students are attending an excursion, they will wear the uniform deemed appropriate to the nature of the outing by the Head of School or co-ordinator of the excursion. The uniform will take one of three forms: full school uniform; sport uniform or sport tracksuit. All students must always wear a school sun hat outside. Students who arrive to the bus or event not in school uniform will not be allowed to attend.

Hairstyles	The School reserves the right to instruct any student to have hair groomed to regulations as interpreted by the school if it is of an unacceptable standard, and/or to suspend the student until the standards are met.	
	<p>General Rules:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair should always be neat and tidy and not of an extreme nature. This includes extreme colour changes, beading and Bali braids. • Length should be no shorter than a #2 cut. • Lines, scalp designs and cuts with extreme variations in length are not permitted. 	
	Boys	Girls
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair must be neat, off the collar, ears and above eyes under normal circumstances. Hair should not be long enough that it needs to be tucked behind ears to keep off eyes. • Boys must be clean shaven. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be worn off the face. • Hair touching the collar must be tied back. • Colourful hair accessories are not permitted.
Blazers	<p>Blazers are required as part of the School Uniform from Year 1 onwards.</p> <p>Years 1-11</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blazers are to be worn to and from School during Terms 2 and 3. • The blazer is to always be worn as the outer layer. The one exception to this rule is when it is raining, and the school rain jacket may be worn over the blazer. <p>Year 12</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Refer to Year 12 Jersey at the bottom of this table. <p>Years 1-12</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • During Terms 2 and 3 Blazers are to be worn to all assemblies and other formal occasions. 	
Jewellery, make-up and body art	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students are not permitted to wear any form of make-up except clear nail varnish. • Students may wear approved school insignia such as school badges, other badges awarded by the school and Duke of Edinburgh Awards, etc. • No jewellery is allowed except a wristwatch and a single silver/gold stud or sleeper earring in each ear. Exceptions to this rule due to religious or cultural reasons need to be approved by the appropriate Head of School. • Boys with piercings may wear clear piercing retainers only. Band-Aids are not an acceptable method to cover a piercing. • All other piercings such as the nose, eyebrows or cartilage, must be only filled with clear piercing retainers only. • No 'body art' (tattoo or henna) is to be visible on any student, whilst wearing Pittwater House uniform, at a Pittwater House event or representing Pittwater House. 	

School Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pre-Kindy: White sandshoes. • Kindy to Year 1: Black leather Velcro strap school shoes or lace-up variety if child can tie their own laces. • Years 2-12: Black leather lace-up school shoes are required. These need to have a heel and not be of a flat soled trainer or 'skate shoe' style. • Shoes should be in good condition and polished. 	
Socks	<p style="text-align: center;">Boys</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boys' Pittwater House socks are available from the Uniform Shop. • They are to be worn with both shorts and trousers all year. 	<p style="text-align: center;">Girls</p> <p>Summer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pre-K to Year 9: Plain white ankle socks only. • Years 10-12: Plain black ankle or crew socks. • Not available from the Uniform Shop. <p>Winter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kindy to Year 2: Long navy socks. • Years 3-12: Navy tights are required. Black tights are not acceptable. Tights should always be in good condition without holes. • Both are available from the Uniform Shop.
School Shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grey knee-length shorts. (Different styles for K-6 and 7-12). • Must be worn with black belt in Years 7-12. • Years 7-12 can wear shorts or trousers. • Purchase only from the Uniform Shop. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kindy to Year 12: tailored navy knee-length shorts available as an option. Purchase only from the Uniform Shop.
School Trousers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tailored trousers available as an option for Years 7-12 only. • Must be worn with black belt. • Purchase only from the Uniform Shop. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kindy to Year 12: Tailored navy pants available as an option. • Purchase only from the Uniform Shop.
Shirts, Ties, Jumpers, Skirts and Dresses	<p>These vary depending on Winter and Summer uniform and stage of enrolment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The School Jumper is a knit navy V-neck (not the Sport Fleece). <p>Notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hemlines on girls' dresses or skirts should be on or just above the knee. • Boys' shirts must be always tucked in. This includes travelling to and from school. • Boys' ties must be tied correctly with the top button of the shirt done up. 	
Sport and PE Uniform	<p>These vary depending on gender, age and sporting activity.</p> <p>Notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sport Fleece and Sport Hoodie are optional attire. • Students must have the correct Pittwater House sport clothing for school carnivals and will not be able to represent the school at external representative level carnivals without the correct uniform. 	
Rain Jacket	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purchasing the Pittwater House rain jacket is optional, however, from Year 5 onwards it is the only rain jacket that is to be worn. • Rain jackets can only be worn outside, when it is raining. • In Terms 2 and 3, the blazer must still be worn under the rain jacket when it is needed to and from school. 	
School Bags	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each student should have a standard Pittwater House school bag issued by the Uniform Shop in which to carry homework, books, lunch and other effects. • Labels, slogans and transfers may not be affixed to the outside of school bags. • Pittwater House sport bags are available from the Uniform Shop and should be used for sport clothing. 	
Year 12 Jersey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Year 12 Jersey is a privilege. Therefore, students may wear it to and from school without the blazer. 	

Lost Property It cannot be too greatly emphasised that the school can do little to assist in recovering lost property if the item is not labelled with the student's full name and the loss is not reported immediately to the Form Teacher, Stage Leader, Assistant Heads or Head of School. If losses are reported at once, the school will take appropriate steps to investigate. Found property is held for a reasonable period at Reception. The school has no legal responsibility for personal items. These are brought on campus at the owner's risk and claims against the school for loss of or damage to personal property will be denied.
